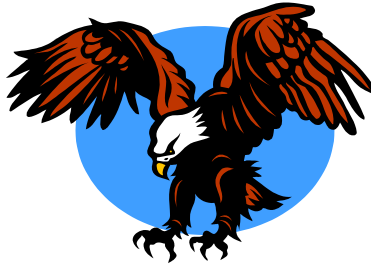

HINTS TO COMPLETE AN EFFECTIVE APPLICATION

The information recorded on this application may be the only “enlightenment” the Hall of Fame Committee will have to determine the nominee’s qualifications for consideration into the Barrington High School Athletic Hall of Fame. It is, therefore, important to fully explain the accomplishments of the nominee. If accomplishments are line item listed, be certain it is easy to understand what the listed item stands for and what its significance may be. **Please support your nomination with newspaper articles/programs/etc. This documented support is crucial to substantiate the Nominee’s qualification for consideration into the BHS Hall of Fame.**

If Possible, please do not use acronyms, BHS, RIIL, etc. may be known to the person filling out the application, but may be meaningless to the individuals evaluating the application.

If special committees or projects have been part of the nominee’s history, please explain as to how it relates as a qualification for induction into the Athletic Hall of Fame. If the nominee received a Coach-of-the-Year award, explain in which sport. Also, please include any other information which will help the committee to decide that the nominee is well-qualified for induction.

Other photos will be requested for the induction ceremony and event program.

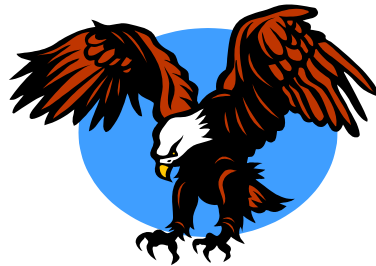

SELECTION PROCEDURES

I. STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

The purpose of the Barrington High School Athletic Hall of Fame is to honor and recognize outstanding individuals who have had a significant accomplishments, achievements, and or contributions through their involvement in high school athletic programs as an Athlete, Administrator, Athletic Director, Coach, Booster and/or Contributor in the Community, etc.

HALL OF FAME ELIGIBILITY

Hall of Fame nominees shall include individuals who, through distinguished achievement, have excelled in one or more high school athletic programs offered through Barrington High School. These individuals may include the following:

- A. Student Athletes
- B. School Administrators (Superintendents, Principals, Athletic Directors)
- C. Coaches
- D. Athletic Trainers
- E. Boosters (Community, team doctors, etc.)

A Hall of Fame committee will judge all nominees on their significant achievements and/or long-term contributions to Barrington High School Athletics.

Student Athlete Nominees must have graduated at least 15 years before entrance in the High School Hall of Fame. Nominees who are listed in (B) through (E) above must have served in that capacity for a minimum of fifteen years (this can be combined in several areas).

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES

- Requests for nomination will be made available by the Barrington Booster Club, Hall of Fame Committee.
- The Hall of Fame Committee shall be composed of at least five (5) individuals.
- The Hall of Fame Committee shall receive the nominations/applications through the President of Barrington Boosters Club.
- The names of all nominees shall be kept confidential.
- Inductees will be formally honored at an appropriate ceremony reception.

II. AWARDS

Each inductee shall receive a suitably engraved award and shall have their name engraved on an Honor Roll Plaque placed at Barrington High School.

III. NOMINATION DEADLINE

All nominations *must* be received by the Barrington Booster Hall of Fame Committee no later than **March 15, 2012**. If the information is not received by the *March 15th* deadline, the candidate will not be considered until the next class selection. A candidate shall be considered no more than three (3) consecutive selection classes, but may be considered again after a one year absence; however, the candidate must be re-nominated.

Each nominee must be submitted in a separate application – *lists of names will not be accepted*.

IV. GENERAL CRITERIA

Nominees must exemplify the highest standards of sportsmanship, ethical conduct, and moral character.

An individual may be nominated in more than one category. The grouping is for screening purposes only to assist those making the nominations. Once nominees are inducted, they will not be categorized, but all are recognized as members of the Barrington High School Athletic Hall of Fame.
