

CONSTITUTION

Of The

BARRINGTON HIGH SCHOOL OUTING CLUB

PREAMBLE

We, the members of the Barrington High School, in order to foster an awareness of the outdoors, do hereby establish this constitution for **The Outing Club** of Barrington High School.

ARTICLE I

NAME

Section 1

The name of this organization will be the **Barrington High School Outing Club**.

ARTICLE II

PURPOSE

Section 1

The purpose of this organization will be to:

1. promote healthy and physical activity for all members of the school;
2. enhance students respect for nature and their surrounding world;
3. provide students with fun activities on the weekends; and
4. pass on a love for the outdoors to future generations at the high school.

ARTICLE III

MEMBERSHIP

Section 1

The Outing Club will be composed of any interested students attending Barrington High School.

Section 2

The members will make a commitment to attend all meetings and involve themselves with the projects and ideas of the club.

ARTICLE IV
OFFICERS

- Section 1 The officers of The Outing Club will be a president, vice president, secretary, and treasurer.
- Section 2 The officers will be elected in September of the current year.
- Section 3 The term of office for the officers will be for one school year.

ARTICLE V
DUTIES AND POWERS OF THE OFFICERS

- Section 1 The President will:
1. preside at all meetings;
 2. call extra meetings when necessary; and
 3. assume all extra responsibilities that may arise during his/her tenure of office.
- Section 2 The Vice-President will:
1. preside at all meetings in the absence of the President; and
 2. attend all meetings.
- Section 3 The Secretary will:
1. preside at all meetings in the absence of the President;
 2. attend all meetings;
 3. furnish, at the end of the year, a complete report of the club's accomplishments; and
 4. take attendance at each meeting.
- Section 4 The Treasurer will:
1. attend all meetings;
 2. keep an accurate record of all expenditures and income of the club; and
 3. organize donations, fund raising.
- Section 5 The members of The Outing Club will:
1. attend all meetings;
 2. share ideas and initiate, plan, and participate in all club activities and events.

ARTICLE VI
DUTIES OF THE ADVISOR

Section 1

The advisor will:

1. attend all meetings and club events;
2. give advice and assistance when needed; and
3. maintain regular communication with the Principal regarding club activities.

ARTICLE VII
DATE AND PLACE OF MEETING

Section 1

The Outing Club will meet on a regular basis. The dates and times of meetings will be determined at the start of each school year.

ARTICLE VIII
DATE EFFECTIVE

Section 1

The Constitution will be effective immediately after ratification by the School Committee.
